The Remuneration Tribunal SA has released its determinations of allowances for members of local government councils, which will take effect following the November 2022 council elections.

The Remuneration Tribunal SA has released its determinations of allowances for members of local government councils. There are two determinations, one for the Adelaide City Council pursuant to section 24 of the *City of Adelaide Act 1998* (Determination No. 3 of 2022) and one for all other councils pursuant to section 76 of the *Local Government Act* (Determination No. 2 of 2022).
