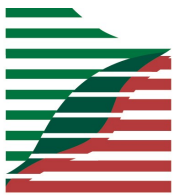


# By-law Authorisations Register and Land Authorised for Aquatic Activities without Formal Written Permission

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# By-law Authorisations Register (2015)

## Conditions

Council has authorised the following positions to:

- Grant permission by notice in writing to the person granted permission;
- Attach conditions to a grant of permission by notice in writing to the person granted permission (including time limits, renewal and transfer requirements) as the person granting permission thinks fit;
- Vary or revoke conditions to a grant of permission by notice in writing to the person granted permission;
- Impose new conditions to a grant of permission by notice in writing to the person granted permission;
- Suspend or revoke a grant of permission at any time by notice in writing to the person granted permission.
