NOTES TO THE APPLICANT

1. Permission is required to:
 - a. attach or affix any moveable sign (including an A-Frame, Inverted T-Sign, Corflute or Banner) to Council property (including Council fences, light poles or signs);
 - b. display any sign on Council roads or land that does not comply with the standard requirements of Council's *Moveable Signs By-law 2015* (including because of its proposed location, size, appearance, design or construction); or
 - c. erect, install, place or display a variable message sign on Council roads or land.
2. Definitions:
 - a. Banner – a moveable sign constituted of a strip of cloth, plastic or other material hung or attached to a pole, fence or other structure (including corflute signs)
 - b. Variable message sign – includes a permanent, portable or vehicle mounted electronic sign (except where the sign is used as a traffic control device)
3. Recommended sizes
 - a. Corflute Signs – 900mm x 900mm
 - b. Canvas Banners – 3 metres x 1 metre or 5 metres x 1 metre (note: please include proposed size of signs as part of this application)
4. The wording to be displayed on variable message signs, banners or corflute signs needs to be submitted with this application.
5. Permission is required to have balloons, flags, streamers or other things attached to an advertising sign. Please include this information as a part of this application.
6. Council may impose any conditions as deemed necessary by the Authorised Officer.
7. A banner or sign cannot be displayed more than one month before and two days after the event it advertises without permission, please include proposed display dates and locations as part of this application.
8. Council approval may be revoked if the applicant fails to comply with any condition of approval or in any other reasonable circumstances.
9. Council may remove any signs that pose a danger to members of the public, restrict the use of the road, do not comply with Council's by-laws or where the conditions of any permission granted are not complied with. You will be notified of their removal and collection arrangements.
10. You may display a moveable sign on a road without Council's permission, provided it complies with the requirements of Council's *Moveable Signs By-law 2015*. The By-law can be viewed online at: https://www.teatreegully.sa.gov.au/Council_documents/By-laws
