

Statutory Declaration

Warning The Oaths Act 1936 provides a maximum penalty of four (4) years imprisonment for any person who knowingly makes a Statutory Declaration which is untrue in any regard.

Warning Under s174A(9) of the Road Traffic Act 1961, if your offence is a parking or stopping offence under the Act or the Australian Road Rules, Council must provide your name to the person you have nominated on this statutory declaration. Council must not provide your address. However, the nominated person might later obtain a copy of your statutory declaration.

Do not send or make payment – a new notice will be issued to the nominated driver.

This Declaration must be completed by the person the notice is issued to:

- It must be witnessed by a Justice of the Peace or a person proclaimed under Part V of the Oaths Act 1936 (eg legal practitioner, a proclaimed police officer)
- Responsibility for payment will remain with the owner if this Declaration is not properly completed and submitted to the City of Tea Tree Gully on or before the due date for payment of the notice.
