Program Overview

Youth Leadership Program is specifically designed to support young people who live, work or study in the City of Tea Tree Gully and who are aged 15 – 22 years.

The program requires a commitment of 2 hours per week, commencing Term 2. Youth Leaders who complete the course will be recognised for their commitments at a graduation ceremony in October 2023.

Weekly sessions will include structured content, relevant leadership training and access to inspirational and interesting guest speakers.

This exciting program has a focus on group learning and tailored outcome based sessions.

It promotes a co led and co designed model with the opportunity to increase your community knowledge and awareness, expand your networks and gain valuable practical skills to support your future leadership journey.
