



Dog Registrations

All dogs aged three months or over, living on the property longer than 14 days must be registered with the Council.

The purpose of this is to provide quick and easy identification of your dog, should they be found wandering or become lost.

Once registered, your dog must wear a registration disc that will identify them to you.

Volunteer Companion Dog Support Program



***Do you need a hand to
exercise your dog?***

Am I eligible for this program?

Are you an older person living at home who needs some help to walk your dog?

A volunteer can visit on a weekly basis to walk your dog.

The assessment process involves a home visit to discuss both the participants and their dog's needs.

This program is free for Council residents.

How can I register for this program?

Either you, a family member or an agency that supports you can refer you to this program. Information about you and your dog will be collected.

A staff member will arrange to visit you at your home to fully explain the program. During this visit the dog's behaviour and their suitability for the program will also be assessed.

A volunteer will then be matched to meet your needs.

What else do I need to know?

- For your safety all our volunteers are screened and reference checked.
- Volunteers are provided with the appropriate training as part of this program.
- Please note that the volunteer walking the dog is legally responsible for the actions of that dog.
- A meeting at a mutually suitable time will be arranged between you, a staff member and the volunteer at your home.
- All participants will be provided with clear advice about rights and responsibilities.
