"This jetty is far more than a replacement for the previous jetty. It is a community facility that is now easily accessible for the disabled and it has not only brought more visitors to Whyalla but has helped transform the way Council is thinking about how to regenerate the city. The jetty is also a catalyst for more economic development in the locality".
