LG Reform – LGA's Submission on Round 2 Regulations



6th December 2021

The LGA has made a submission to the Minister on the local government reform draft round 2 regulations based on feedback obtained from members.

The Office of Local Government (OLG) sought comments from the LGA on a number of draft regulations (the Round 2 Regulations) which will support the commencement of the second round of reform changes to the *Local Government Act 1999*.

The LGA sought feedback from member councils on the proposed Round 2 Regulations with the consultation period ending on 24 November 2021. More information on the Round 2 Regulations and access to the LGA's summary paper can be found here.

The LGA's submission supported the majority of the proposed Regulations on the basis that they reflect negotiated positions reached during the progression of the *Statutes Amendment (Local Government Review) Act 2021*. However, following consultation with members, the LGA suggested a small number of amendments. The LGA will continue to work with OLG to clarify requirements and will provide additional support to councils through development of guidance and information papers.
