New toilets at River Torrens Linear Park

You can now stay a wee bit longer at River Torrens Linear Park with two new public toilets now open for business.

In response to public demand from park visitors and residents, accessible unisex toilets were recently installed in the park at Dernancourt and Highbury.

Each facility includes a baby change table, along with an exterior drinking fountain.

New public toilets were also installed last year at Solandra Reserve at Modbury North, Golden Fields at Golden Grove, Edinburgh Reserve at Modbury (including an accessible adult-size change table) and Kingfisher Reserve at Modbury Heights.

Public toilets in parks and reserves are open during daylight hours only.
