



## Terms and Conditions

1. The Cloth Nappy and Reusable Sanitary Product Rebate Program includes sanitary pads, sanitary cups, leak-proof underwear, cloth nappies, swim nappies, reusable wipes associated with cloth nappies, reusable nursing breast pads and wet bags.
2. The maximum available rebate per application is:
  - a. For reusable sanitary products – 50% of the total purchase price as detailed on the receipt(s) or proof of purchase(s) can be applied for, up to a maximum of \$50.
  - b. For reusable cloth nappies - 50% of the total purchase price as detailed on the receipt(s) or proof of purchase(s) can be applied for, up to a maximum of \$150.
3. To be eligible for the rebate program, the applicants must reside in the City of Tea Tree Gully. Proof of residency must be provided – e.g. a Council Rate notice or government notice showing a current residential address. Notices must be dated within three (3) months of the date of application. Drivers Licence and Proof of Age cards may also be accepted as proof of residency.
4. Applicants are entitled to make one (1) application per household for each rebate every three (3) years.
5. The applicant must provide a copy of the receipt or proof of purchase for the reusable item(s) they are claiming. It must include the company name and ABN, date, and clear identification of the product(s) and cost of each item(s) purchased.
6. The receipt or proof of purchase must be no older than six (6) months from the date of application. A partial copy of receipt or proof of purchase will not be accepted.
7. Pre-owned wearables may be eligible for rebate if adequate proof can be provided. This is at Council's discretion.
8. Transport/freight/shipping/postage costs, hire, wipes containers, nappy covers or single-use items are ineligible for a rebate as part of the Cloth Nappy and Reusable Sanitary Product Rebate Program.

9. To apply for rebates under the Cloth Nappy and Reusable Sanitary Product Rebate Program, the applicant will need to complete and submit the appropriate application form via the Tea Tree Gully Council's website.
10. It is the sole responsibility of the applicant to supply all information required to appropriately assess their application.
11. Council holds no responsibility for following up missing or incomplete information provided by the applicant.
12. Council holds the right to reject any application for any reason it deems appropriate, including but not limited to where there is proof or suspicion that the applicant may derive commercial benefit from the rebate.
13. By applying, the applicant declares that the information provided is true and correct.
14. The Cloth Nappy and Reusable Sanitary Product Rebate Program may be paused or discontinued, either in part or in full, at any time and without notice, should the budget allocation be exhausted or for any other reason deemed appropriate by Council.
