## INFORMATION REPORT

#### Blackspot Funding Approval - Roundabout Kelly Road and Wright Road, Modbury (D22/56780)

The City of Tea Tree Gully has been successful in obtaining grant funding under the Australian Government Blackspot Program 2022-23 to upgrade the roundabout at the intersection of Wright Road and Kelly Road, Modbury.

To be eligible for Blackspot funding, at least 3 casualty (injury) crashes need to have occurred in the past 5 years. The project also needs to achieve a Benefit-Cost Ratio (BCR) of 2 or greater.

Three right angle casualty crashes have occurred in the past 5 years. The crash data is provided below:

- ☒ 15/07/2019 – Right Angle Crash – Vehicle straight ahead in north direction along Kelly road hits a pedal cycle heading along Wright road in westerly direction.
- ☒ 26/03/2019 – Right Angle Crash – Vehicle heading west on Wright road hits a pedal cycle heading along Kelly road in south direction.
- ☒ 22/03/2019- Right Angle Crash – Motor cycle straight ahead in east direction along Wright road hits a vehicle travelling south along Kelly road.

Considering the high number of right-angle crashes, the main improvement proposed will be the modification to the roundabout to reduce the high entry speeds. In addition, improved lighting will be provided as well as new kerb ramps and pedestrian refuge areas.

Based on the improvements described above, a Benefit-Cost ratio of 2.19 was achieved.

As a result, Council has received confirmation that grant funding will be provided to the sum of \$ 251,658 (GST Inclusive).

Under the conditions of Blackspot Funding the Council will need to enter into a funding deed with Department for Infrastructure and Transport (DIT). The deed contains information about project funding, conditions, reporting and payment arrangements. Also, as a condition of the grant the works should be completed by the end of June 2023. This Deed needs to be referred to Council for endorsement as part of the funding offer.

Council staff will procure detailed survey and design services and following approvals, will engage Council staff or a Contractor to undertake the works.

A draft concept design, prepared during the application process, is attached to the report for reference.
